

January 2019 scholarships/programs

Accounting, Business or Math Majors: apply for the \$500 Mo Society of CPA's scholarship. Deadline is Jan 23. Tell Ms. Mueller or one of your teachers if you are interested so we can send you the link.

Need a job? The Mo Dept of Revenue is looking for tax assistants. Pay is 10-11 dollars an hour. Work Mon-Friday from 4-9. Go to www.dor.mo.gov/humanresources/ to apply.

Females interested in a career in education or a related field: apply for the Delta Kappa Gamma scholarship. Amount not listed. This is a local! All information must be postmarked by Jan 31. See Mueller for the application.

Mizzou and Moberly Area Community College have developed a co-enrollment program so students can experience the depth and breadth of a 4-year college while enjoying the affordability of a two year institution. You can use the A+ funds. Can live on MU campus and use all the MU services. For more information, pick up a paper from Mueller.

By the way, East Central and MS&T in Rolla have a similar program.

Seniors going to tech school or college whose employer or parent(s) is a member of the West Side Business Association: Pick up the West Side Business Association scholarship application. This scholarship is for \$1000, and the postmark deadline is April 1.

All seniors going to a tech school or college: Pick up from Mueller's office the \$2000 MFA Scholarship application. Must be returned to Mueller with a senior picture by March 8. This is a local! DO NOT fill in the line that asks for the "name and location of MFA Agency sponsoring the scholarship."

All seniors going to an in-state college: Apply for the MAMIC scholarship for \$1000. Mueller has the forms and you must return them to her by Feb 20.

High School Seniors: write an essay sharing why life is worth it, distracted driving is not. We'll be awarding 10 winners with a \$2,000 scholarship for the 2019-2020 school year. Applications must be submitted online by February 1, 2019. For full details, visit ufgworthit.com/contact/scholarship.

Seniors active in choral music: apply for the Cantorum/J. Patrick Healey Scholarship for \$500. Must complete the application and show your exceptional interest in choral music, although you do NOT have to major in music – you can major in anything. In addition to the materials required for the common scholarship, applicant must include: (1) A brief written personal statement about the importance of singing in his/her life. (2) A brief resume highlighting his/her musical "career," including musical instruction, activities, and performances. (3) A brief recommendation from a choral director familiar with

his/her work as a member of a chorus. Must be completed and to Jefferson City address by Feb 8. See Mueller for the application.

Juniors: consider attending Missouri Boys State from June 15-22 or Missouri Girls State from June 23-29. Lots of leadership training and information about the operations of government. Both are held on the campus of UCM. With both, there are scholarship opportunities, and they look great on resumes!
